

Important Update to the OPA Group Health Insurance Program

Over the past several years, the Ontario Pharmacists Association (OPA) has worked diligently to maintain a competitive and sustainable Group Health Insurance Program for our members. Despite multiple adjustments, rising claims—particularly in prescription drug coverage—have made it increasingly difficult to keep premiums affordable.

As a result, effective January 1, 2026, prescription drug coverage will no longer be included in the program.

We recognize this is a significant change and understand the impact it may have. This decision was not made lightly, but it is necessary to ensure the long-term viability of the program and to continue offering meaningful health benefits to our members.

What remains strong in your coverage:

- Extended Health Benefits: Continued support for paramedical services, vision care, and medical equipment.
- **Dental Coverage**: Comprehensive dental care including preventive and restorative services.
- **Mental Health Support**: Access to licensed professionals for psychological and emotional well-being.
